AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the standards enacted 24 under this Act shall be applicable to a data collection form that is created or revised 25 after the effective date of this Act, and the standards shall be applicable to all data 26 collection forms no later than January 1, 2002.

27 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 28 July 1, 1998.

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
