- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 17 Article Courts and Judicial Proceedings

- 19 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO A CIVIL CASE THAT IS ORIGINALLY FILED 20 IN THE DISTRICT COURT AND TRANSFERRED TO A CIRCUIT COURT.
- 21 (B) SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION, AT ANY TIME BEFORE 60
- 22 DAYS OF A SCHEDULED TRIAL DATE IN A CIRCUIT COURT, A PARTY SHALL HAVE THE
- 23 RIGHT TO AMEND THE AD DAMNUM CLAUSE OF THE PARTY'S COMPLAINT.
- 24 (C) A PARTY WHO INTENDS TO AMEND THE AD DAMNUM CLAUSE OF THE
- 25 PARTY'S COMPLAINT SHALL FILE THE AMENDMENT WITH THE CLERK OF THE COURT

- 1 (D) THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION ARE IN ADDITION TO THE PROVISIONS 2 OF THE MARYLAND RULES RELATING TO AMENDMENTS OF PLEADINGS.

- 4 construed only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect
- 5 on or application to any case transferred to a circuit court from the District Court
- 6 before the effective date of this Act.
- 7 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 8 October 1, 1998.
