- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 16 (a) The Court of Special Appeals shall hold its sessions in the City of
- 17 Annapolis, OR IN OTHER PLACES DESIGNATED BY THE CHIEF JUDGE, AND at the time
- 18 or times it prescribes by rule. Its sessions shall continue not less than ten months in
- 19 each year, if the business before it so requires.
- 20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 21 October 1, 1998.
