BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article - Transportation** 13 14 21-506. 15 Where a sidewalk is provided, a pedestrian may not walk along and on an (a) 16 adjacent roadway. 17 Where a sidewalk is not provided[,]: (b) 18 [a] A pedestrian who walks along and on a highway may walk only (1) 19 on the left shoulder, if practicable, or on the left side of the roadway, as near as 20 practicable to the edge of the roadway, facing any traffic that might approach from 21 the opposite direction; AND EACH PEDESTRIAN WHO WALKS, JOGS, OR RUNS FOR SPORT OR 22 23 EXERCISE ALONG AND ON A HIGHWAY AFTER DUSK SHALL WEAR CLOTHING THAT 24 INCORPORATES REFLECTIVE MATERIAL ON THE FRONT AND BACK THAT IS CLEARLY

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
