1 AN ACT concerning

Motor Vehicles - Commemorative License Plates - Education

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Motor Vehicle Administration to issue certain

- 4 commemorative license plates to honor education; authorizing the
- 5 Administration to adopt regulations to govern the issuance of commemorative
- 6 license plates under this Act; specifying the vehicles that are eligible for
- 7 commemorative license plates under this Act; authorizing the Administration to
- 8 establish and charge a fee; requiring the Administration to disburse any surplus
- 9 money received from fees paid for license plates under this Act to the counties to
- 10 support secondary education; providing for the design of the commemorative
- 11 license plates; and generally relating to commemorative license plates.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

20 13-618.1.

(A) THE OWNER OF A VEHICLE, OR A LESSEE OF THE VEHICLE UNDER A
LEASE NOT INTENDED AS SECURITY, OR A DIRECTOR, OFFICER, EMPLOYEE, OR
PARTNER OF A BUSINESS ENTITY THAT OWNS THE VEHICLE CONSIDERED ELIGIBLE
BY THE ADMINISTRATION MAY APPLY TO THE ADMINISTRATION FOR THE
ASSIGNMENT OF A COMMEMORATIVE REGISTRATION PLATE UNDER THIS SECTION IF
THE VEHICLE IS INCLUDED IN ONE OF THE FOLLOWING CLASSES

- 26 THE VEHICLE IS INCLUDED IN ONE OF THE FOLLOWING CLASSES:
- 27 (1) A CLASS A (PASSENGER) VEHICLE;
- 28 (2) A CLASS B (FOR HIRE) VEHICLE;

1 (3) A CLASS E (TRUCK) VEHICLE WITH A MANUFACTURER'S RATED 2 CAPACITY OF ONE TON OR LESS;

3 (4) A CLASS G (TRAILER) VEHICLE; OR

4 (5) A CLASS M (MULTIPURPOSE) VEHICLE.

5 (B) (1) IN ADDITION TO THE ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE OTHERWISE
6 REQUIRED UNDER THIS TITLE, AN OWNER OF A VEHICLE ASSIGNED A
7 COMMEMORATIVE REGISTRATION PLATE UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL PAY THE FEE
8 SET BY THE ADMINISTRATION WHEN THE NEW REGISTRATION PLATES ARE ISSUED
9 TO THE VEHICLE UNDER THIS SECTION.

10(2)(I)THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL SET THE FEE AT A LEVEL THAT11WILL ENABLE THE ADMINISTRATION TO RECOVER ITS COSTS UNDER THIS SECTION.

12 (II) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY CHARGE A FEE THAT IS 13 SUFFICIENT TO RESULT IN A SURPLUS AFTER COSTS ARE SUBTRACTED.

(III) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL RETAIN A PORTION OF THE FEE
THAT IS SUFFICIENT TO ALLOW THE ADMINISTRATION TO RECOVER ANY COSTS OF
ISSUING AND DISTRIBUTING COMMEMORATIVE PLATES UNDER THIS SECTION.

(IV) ANY SURPLUS MONEYS REMAINING AFTER THE
 ADMINISTRATION HAS RECOVERED THE COSTS OF ISSUING A COMMEMORATIVE
 PLATE UNDER THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE RETAINED BY OR TRANSFERRED TO ANY
 AGENCY OF THE STATE FOR ANY PURPOSE.

(V) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBPARAGRAPH (IV) OF THIS PARAGRAPH,
 THE SURPLUS MONEYS MAY BE RETAINED FOR THE PURPOSE DESCRIBED IN
 PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

(3) THE SURPLUS MONEYS SHALL BE DISBURSED BY THE
ADMINISTRATION TO EACH COUNTY ON A PRO RATA BASIS, BASED ON THE NUMBER
OF VEHICLE OWNERS FROM EACH COUNTY REQUESTING COMMEMORATIVE PLATES
UNDER THIS SECTION, FOR USE BY THAT COUNTY FOR PUBLIC SECONDARY
EDUCATION.

29 (C) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS NOT INCONSISTENT
30 WITH THE MARYLAND VEHICLE LAW TO GOVERN THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL
31 REGISTRATION PLATES UNDER THIS SECTION.

32 (D) (1) A SPECIAL REGISTRATION NUMBER AS SPECIFIED BY THE 33 ADMINISTRATION AND ASSIGNED UNDER THIS SECTION MAY CONSIST OF:

- 35 1. LETTERS; AND
- 36 2. NUMERALS; AND

1(II)ANY DESIGN APPROVED BY THE ADMINISTRATION THAT2ADEQUATELY HONORS THE EDUCATIONAL THEME WHICH THE PLATE3COMMEMORATES.

4 (2) A SPECIAL REGISTRATION NUMBER OR DESIGN ASSIGNED UNDER 5 THIS SECTION SHALL BE DISPLAYED ON THE REGISTRATION PLATES FOR THE 6 VEHICLE.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect8 October 1, 1998.
