1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Commercial Law - Checks and Other Instruments - Rights of Holders**

3 FOR the purpose of reenacting certain provisions of law inadvertently repealed by
4 Chapter 91 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1996; clarifying and
5 confirming the intent of the General Assembly that certain holders of certain
6 dishonored checks and other instruments may recover certain amounts from a
7 maker or a drawer under certain circumstances; providing for the effective date
8 of this Act; making this Act retroactive; and generally relating to dishonored
9 checks and other instruments.

13 Dishonored Checks and Other Instruments - Collection"

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 **Article - Commercial Law**

2 SUBTITLE 8. DISHONORED CHECKS AND OTHER INSTRUMENTS - COLLECTION.

4 (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
5 INDICATED.

6 (B) "CHECK" HAS THE MEANING PROVIDED IN § 3-104(F) OF THIS ARTICLE.

7 (C) "DISHONOR" HAS THE MEANING PROVIDED IN § 3-502 OF THIS ARTICLE.

8 (D) "DRAWER" HAS THE MEANING PROVIDED IN § 3-103(A)(3) OF THIS ARTICLE.

9 (E) "HOLDER" HAS THE MEANING PROVIDED IN § 1-201(20) OF THIS ARTICLE.

10 (F) "HOLDER IN DUE COURSE" HAS THE MEANING PROVIDED IN § 3-302 OF
11 THIS ARTICLE.12 (G) "INSTRUMENT" HAS THE MEANING PROVIDED IN § 3-104(B) OF THIS
13 ARTICLE.

14 (H) "ISSUE" HAS THE MEANING PROVIDED IN § 3-105 OF THIS ARTICLE.

15 (I) "MAKER" HAS THE MEANING PROVIDED IN § 3-103(A)(5) OF THIS ARTICLE.

16 (J) "NEGOTIATION" HAS THE MEANING PROVIDED IN § 3-201 OF THIS
17 ARTICLE.18 (K) "NOTICE OF DISHONOR" HAS THE MEANING PROVIDED IN § 3-503 OF THIS
19 ARTICLE.20 (L) "STOP PAYMENT ORDER" HAS THE MEANING PROVIDED IN § 4-403 OF THIS
21 ARTICLE.

23 (A) WHEN A CHECK OR OTHER INSTRUMENT HAS BEEN DISHONORED BY
24 NONACCEPTANCE OR NONPAYMENT AND HAS NOT BEEN PAID WITHIN 10 DAYS, THE
25 HOLDER TO WHOM THE CHECK OR OTHER INSTRUMENT WAS ISSUED OR
26 NEGOTIATED MAY SEND A NOTICE OF DISHONOR TO THE MAKER OR DRAWER AS
27 PROVIDED UNDER THIS SECTION.28 (B) IF A CHECK OR OTHER INSTRUMENT HAS NOT BEEN PAID WITHIN 30 DAYS
29 AFTER THE HOLDER HAS SENT A NOTICE OF DISHONOR TO THE MAKER OR DRAWER,
30 THE MAKER OR DRAWER OF A CHECK OR OTHER INSTRUMENT THAT HAS BEEN
31 DISHONORED MAY BE LIABLE FOR:

32 (1) THE AMOUNT OF THE CHECK OR INSTRUMENT;

1 (2) A COLLECTION FEE OF UP TO \$25; AND

2 (3) AN AMOUNT UP TO 2 TIMES THE AMOUNT OF THE CHECK, BUT NOT
3 MORE THAN \$1,000.

4 (C) (1) (I) THE HOLDER OF A CHECK OR OTHER INSTRUMENT THAT HAS
5 BEEN DISHONORED MAY SEEK THE DAMAGES PROVIDED UNDER THIS SECTION IN
6 ANY DISTRICT COURT OF THE STATE 30 DAYS AFTER A NOTICE OF DISHONOR HAS
7 BEEN SENT BY MAIL TO THE LAST KNOWN ADDRESS OF THE MAKER OR DRAWER.

8 (II) THE HOLDER SHALL OBTAIN A CERTIFICATE OF MAILING FROM
9 THE U.S. POSTAL SERVICE FOR EACH NOTICE SENT BY THE HOLDER UNDER
10 SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH.

11 (2) A NOTICE OF DISHONOR SENT BY A HOLDER UNDER THIS SECTION
12 TO A MAKER OR DRAWER OF A DISHONORED CHECK OR OTHER INSTRUMENT SHALL
13 SUBSTANTIALLY COMPLY WITH THE FORM PRESCRIBED IN § 15-803 OF THIS
14 SUBTITLE.

15 (D) A HOLDER MAY NOT RECOVER ANY DAMAGES UNDER SUBSECTION (B)(3)
16 OF THIS SECTION IF:

17 (1) THE HOLDER HAS DEMANDED OF, AND RECEIVED FROM, THE MAKER
18 OR DRAWER:

19 (I) COLLECTION COSTS IN EXCESS OF THE COLLECTION FEE
20 PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (B)(2) OF THIS SECTION; OR

21 (II) COLLECTION COSTS WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER THE MAILING OF
22 THE NOTICE OF DISHONOR, UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION; OR

23 (2) THE DISHONORED CHECK OR OTHER INSTRUMENT PROVIDES FOR
24 THE PAYMENT OF COLLECTION COSTS IN THE EVENT OF DISHONOR.

25 (E) (1) IT SHALL BE A COMPLETE DEFENSE TO ANY ACTION BROUGHT
26 UNDER THIS SECTION BY ANY HOLDER OF A DISHONORED CHECK OR OTHER
27 INSTRUMENT THAT, WITHIN 30 DAYS FROM THE MAILING OF THE NOTICE OF
28 DISHONOR, THE MAKER OR DRAWER HAS PAID TO THE HOLDER THE FULL AMOUNT
29 OF THE CHECK OR OTHER INSTRUMENT AND COLLECTION COSTS OF NOT MORE
30 THAN \$25.

31 (2) IT SHALL BE A COMPLETE DEFENSE TO ANY ACTION BOUGHT UNDER
32 THIS SECTION BY A HOLDER TO WHOM A DISHONORED CHECK OR OTHER
33 INSTRUMENT WAS ISSUED THAT THE DISHONOR OF THE CHECK OR OTHER
34 INSTRUMENT WAS DUE TO A JUSTIFIABLE STOP PAYMENT ORDER OR TO THE
35 ATTACHMENT OF THE ACCOUNT.

36 (3) IN ANY ACTION BROUGHT UNDER THIS SECTION BY A HOLDER OR
37 HOLDER IN DUE COURSE TO WHOM A DISHONORED CHECK OR OTHER INSTRUMENT
38 WAS NEGOTIATED, THE ACTION IS SUBJECT TO ALL VALID DEFENSES THAT MAY BE

1 RAISED BY THE MAKER OR DRAWER AGAINST THE HOLDER OR HOLDER IN DUE
2 COURSE UNDER TITLE 3 OF THIS ARTICLE.

3 15-803.

4 (A) A NOTICE OF DISHONOR SENT BY A HOLDER TO A MAKER OR DRAWER
5 UNDER § 15-802 OF THIS SUBTITLE SHALL SUBSTANTIALLY COMPLY WITH THE
6 FOLLOWING FORM:

19 SUFFICIENT MONEY TO PAY SUCH CHECK OR INSTRUMENT IN FULL AND A
20 COLLECTION FEE OF \$ ____ (NOT MORE THAN \$25). IF PAYMENT OF THE ABOVE
21 AMOUNTS IS NOT MADE WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE MAILING OF THIS NOTICE OF
22 DISHONOR, YOU MAY BE LIABLE UNDER § 15-802 OF THE COMMERCIAL LAW ARTICLE,
23 IN ADDITION TO THE AMOUNT OF THE CHECK OR INSTRUMENT AND A COLLECTION
24 FEE OF UP TO \$25, FOR AN AMOUNT UP TO 2 TIMES THE AMOUNT OF THE CHECK OR
25 INSTRUMENT, BUT NOT MORE THAN \$1,000. IN ADDITION, YOU MAY BE PROSECUTED
26 UNDER THE MARYLAND CRIMINAL CODE (ARTICLE 27, §§ 140 THROUGH 144) AND
27 SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING PENALTIES:

28 (1) IF THE PROPERTY OR SERVICES HAS A VALUE OF \$300 OR MORE, A
29 FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 15 YEARS, OR
30 BOTH;

31 (2) IF THE PROPERTY OR SERVICES HAS A VALUE OF LESS THAN \$300, A
32 FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$100 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 18 MONTHS, OR
33 BOTH.

34 IT SHALL BE A COMPLETE DEFENSE TO ANY ACTION BROUGHT BY ANY HOLDER
35 UNDER § 15-802 OF THE COMMERCIAL LAW ARTICLE THAT, WITHIN 30 DAYS FROM
36 THE MAILING OF "THE NOTICE OF DISHONORED CHECK", THE MAKER OR DRAWER
37 HAS PAID THE HOLDER THE FULL AMOUNT OF THE CHECK OR INSTRUMENT AND
38 COLLECTION COSTS OF NOT MORE THAN \$25. A HOLDER MAY NOT RECOVER ANY
39 DAMAGES IF THE HOLDER HAS DEMANDED OF, AND RECEIVED FROM, THE MAKER OR

1 DRAWER COLLECTION COSTS EXCEEDING \$25.

2 IT SHALL BE A COMPLETE DEFENSE TO ANY ACTION BROUGHT UNDER § 15-802 OF
3 THE COMMERCIAL LAW ARTICLE BY A HOLDER TO WHOM A DISHONORED CHECK OR
4 OTHER INSTRUMENT WAS ISSUED THAT THE DISHONOR OF THE CHECK OR OTHER
5 INSTRUMENT WAS DUE TO A JUSTIFIABLE STOP PAYMENT ORDER OR TO THE
6 ATTACHMENT OF THE ACCOUNT.

7 IN ANY ACTION BROUGHT UNDER § 15-802 OF THE COMMERCIAL LAW ARTICLE BY A
8 HOLDER OR HOLDER IN DUE COURSE TO WHOM A DISHONORED CHECK OR OTHER
9 INSTRUMENT WAS NEGOTIATED, THE ACTION IS SUBJECT TO ALL VALID DEFENSES
10 THAT MAY BE RAISED BY THE MAKER OR DRAWER AGAINST THE HOLDER OR HOLDER
11 IN DUE COURSE UNDER TITLE 3 OF THE COMMERCIAL LAW ARTICLE."

12 (B) THE HOLDER TO WHOM A CHECK OR OTHER INSTRUMENT IS ISSUED OR
13 NEGOTIATED MAY POST A CLEARLY CONSPICUOUS NOTICE AT OR NEAR THE POINT
14 OF RECEIPT STATING THE LIABILITY OF THE MAKER OR DRAWER FOR THE
15 COLLECTION FEE AND DAMAGES PROVIDED IN § 15-802 OF THIS SUBTITLE AND
16 CRIMINAL PENALTIES PROVIDED IN ARTICLE 27, § 143 OF THE CODE.

17 15-804.

18 (A) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE, §§ 15-802
19 AND 15-803 OF THIS SUBTITLE DO NOT APPLY TO ANY CHECK:

20 (1) TENDERED BY A MAKER OR DRAWER IN COMPLETE OR PARTIAL
21 SATISFACTION OF A PREEXISTING CREDIT OR LOAN OBLIGATION INCURRED BY THE
22 MAKER OR DRAWER UNDER TITLE 12 OF THIS ARTICLE; OR

23 (2) THAT IS NOT A BAD CHECK AS DESCRIBED UNDER ARTICLE 27, § 141
24 OF THE CODE.

25 (B) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS ARTICLE, §§ 15-802
26 AND 15-803 OF THIS SUBTITLE SHALL BE CONSTRUED TO GRANT ANY HOLDER TO
27 WHOM THE CHECK OR OTHER INSTRUMENT WAS ISSUED OR NEGOTIATED A RIGHT
28 OF RECOURSE WHICH IS ALTERNATIVE TO ANY OTHER RIGHT OF RECOURSE
29 GRANTED TO THAT HOLDER UNDER TITLE 3 OF THIS ARTICLE.

30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is retroactive to
31 January 1, 1997.

32 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
33 July 1, 1998.
