A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Allegany County State's Attorney - Salary**

3 FOR the purpose of increasing the salary of the State's Attorney for Allegany County;

4 providing that this Act does not apply to the salary or compensation of the
5 incumbent State's Attorney; making stylistic changes; and generally relating to
6 the compensation of the State's Attorney for Allegany County.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 10 - Legal Officials**

16 (b) (1) In Allegany County, [(1)] the State's Attorney's salary shall be [80
17 percent] BASED ON THE FOLLOWING PERCENTAGES of a District Court judge's salary
18 IN EFFECT ON DECEMBER 31 OF THE YEAR IMMEDIATELY BEFORE THE START OF
19 THE STATE'S ATTORNEY'S TERM OF OFFICE:

20 (I) 85 PERCENT IN CALENDAR YEAR 1999;

21 (II) 87.5 PERCENT IN CALENDAR YEAR 2000; AND

22 (III) 90 PERCENT IN CALENDAR YEAR 2001 AND IN EACH
23 SUBSEQUENT CALENDAR YEAR.

24 (2) While in office, the State's Attorney may not engage in the private
25 practice of law.

1 [(2)] (3) The State's Attorney may appoint two deputy State's Attorneys.
2 The deputy State's Attorneys' salaries may not be less than 80 percent of the salary of
3 the State's Attorney. The deputies shall fulfill the responsibilities of their positions on
4 a full-time basis. The State's Attorney may appoint as many assistant State's
5 Attorneys as are funded and authorized by the Allegany County Commissioners.

6 [(3)] (4) The State's Attorney, the deputy State's Attorney, or an
7 assistant State's Attorney shall present cases to the grand jury and perform other acts
8 and duties in relation to the grand jury, the Circuit Court including the Juvenile
9 Court, and the District Court as are necessary and proper in the judgment of the
10 State's Attorney.

11 [(4)] (5) The State's Attorney shall appoint a county and an assistant
12 county investigator in accordance with the provisions of §§ 12-1A and 12-1B of the
13 Allegany County Code. The county and assistant county investigator shall be funded
14 under § 12-1A of the Allegany County Code.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III,
16 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or
17 apply to the salary or compensation of the State's Attorney for Allegany County in
18 office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the
19 salary or compensation of the State's Attorney for Allegany County shall take effect at
20 the beginning of the next following term of office.

21 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
22 October 1, 1998.
