- 7 (1) THE AMOUNT OF A PROPERTY TAX CREDIT UNDER THIS SECTION;
- 8 (2) THE DURATION OF A PROPERTY TAX CREDIT UNDER THIS SECTION;
- 9 (3) THE CRITERIA AND QUALIFICATIONS NECESSARY TO RECEIVE THE
- 10 CREDIT;
- 11 (4) THE APPLICATION OF A PROPERTY TAX CREDIT UNDER THIS
- 12 SECTION TO EXISTING AUTOMATIC SPRINKLER SYSTEMS; AND
- 13 (4) (5) ANY OTHER PROVISION NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THIS

- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 16 July 1, 1998.
