BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 3 Article 83A - Department of Business and Economic Development 4 5-402. 5 Within 60 days following any submission date, the Secretary may (e) 6 designate one or more enterprise zones from among the applications submitted to the 7 Secretary on or before that submission date, provided, however, that the Secretary 8 may not designate more than 6 enterprise zones in any 12 month period and no 9 county may receive more than 1 area designated as an enterprise zone in any 10 calendar year.
