21 22	(A) IN THIS SECTION, "UNIT" MEANS AN OFFICER, UNIT, OR INSTITUTION OF STATE GOVERNMENT.

23 Except as otherwise provided by law AND AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) (B)

24 OF THIS SECTION, at the end of a fiscal year the unspent balance of each

25 appropriation that was made for that fiscal year to [an officer or unit of the State

26 government or to an institution reverts] A UNIT SHALL REVERT to the General Fund

(C) (1) WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND
 MANAGEMENT, UP TO 50% OF THE UNSPENT OR UNENCUMBERED BALANCE OF THE
 APPROPRIATION AUTHORIZED FOR A FISCAL YEAR FOR USE BY A UNIT MAY NOT
 REVERT TO THE GENERAL FUND, BUT SHALL REMAIN AVAILABLE FOR EXPENDITURE
 WITHIN THE UNIT IN THE SUCCEEDING FISCAL YEAR.

7 MANAGEMENT AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT
8 ARTICLE, TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY BEFORE THE END OF THE NEXT FISCAL YEAR
9 ON THE AMOUNT OF FUNDS CARRIED OVER BY THE UNIT UNDER THIS SUBSECTION
10 AND HOW THOSE FUNDS WERE EXPENDED.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 12 July 1, 1998.
