- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (d) (2) An applicant for a certified social worker-clinical license shall have:
- 19 (i) 1. A master's degree in social work and documentation of
- 20 clinical course work from an accredited college or university and based on a graduate
- 21 social work program accredited by the Council on Social Work Education; and
- 22 [(ii)] 2. 2 years of supervised clinical social work experience of at
- 23 least 3,000 hours after receiving the master's degree with a minimum of 144 hours of
- 24 periodic direct face-to-face supervision provided in not less than 2 consecutive years
- 25 and not more than 6 consecutive years and where the supervision is part of the
- 26 employment contract and the supervisor is a licensed certified social worker-clinical
- 27 and is provided by and accountable to the employer; OR

- 1 (II) 1. A MASTER'S DEGREE IN PSYCHOLOGY AND
- 2 DOCUMENTATION OF CLINICAL COURSE WORK FROM AN ACCREDITED COLLEGE OR
- 3 UNIVERSITY AND BASED ON AN ACCREDITED GRADUATE PSYCHOLOGY PROGRAM;
- 4 AND
- 5 2. 2 YEARS OF SUPERVISED CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGY
- 6 EXPERIENCE OF AT LEAST 3,000 HOURS AFTER RECEIVING THE MASTER'S DEGREE
- 7 WITH A MINIMUM OF 144 HOURS OF PERIODIC FACE-TO-FACE SUPERVISION
- 8 PROVIDED IN NOT LESS THAN 2 CONSECUTIVE YEARS AND NOT MORE THAN 6
- 9 CONSECUTIVE YEARS AND WHERE THE SUPERVISION IS PART OF THE EMPLOYMENT
- 10 CONTRACT AND THE SUPERVISOR IS A LICENSED PSYCHOLOGIST AND IS PROVIDED
- 11 BY AND ACCOUNTABLE TO THE EMPLOYER.
- 12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 13 October 1, 1998.
