1 **Article - State Personnel and Pensions** 2 29-115. 3 (a) If a disability retiree is under normal retirement age, the Board of Trustees 4 may require the disability retiree to undergo a yearly medical examination. 5 [(1)]The retiree shall be examined by a physician chosen by the Board of (b) 6 Trustees[. 7 The examination shall be at the retiree's residence or other] AT A 8 place agreed on by the retiree and the physician conducting the examination. 9 (c) If a retiree who is under normal retirement age refuses a medical 10 examination, the Board of Trustees may stop payment of the retiree's allowance until 11 the retiree withdraws the refusal. 12 (d) If a retiree's refusal of a medical examination continues for 1 year, the 13 Board of Trustees may revoke the retiree's rights in the retiree's [pension] 14 DISABILITY RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE.
