	(b) (1) The Commission shall define, by rule or regulation, the types and classes of charges that may not be changed, except as specified in § 19-219 of this subtitle.
	(2) (I) THE COMMISSION SHALL DEFINE THE TYPES AND CLASSES OF HOSPITAL OUTPATIENT SERVICES FOR WHICH A HOSPITAL MAY CHARGE LESS THAN A COMMISSION-APPROVED RATE SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:
