13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary or compensation of the Sheriff of Howard County in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation of the Sheriff of Howard County shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office. 					

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectOctober 1, 1998.
