- 1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to §§ 21-803.1
- 2 and 27-101(r) of the Transportation Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act, when
- 3 altering the fines specified in the penalty deposit schedule, the Chief Judge of the
- 4 District Court shall adjust the fines for speeding in a school zone in violation of this
- 5 act as necessary to ensure that the fines for school zone violations are double the
- 6 penalty deposit amount that may otherwise be imposed for exceeding the speed limit
- 7 in areas other than school zones in violation of § 21-801.1 of the Transportation
- 8 Article.
- 9 SECTION 2. 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 10 effect October 1, 1998.
