- 5 recruit and retain qualified institutional educators. For Fiscal Year 1999 and every
- 6 third fiscal year thereafter, the Secretary of Budget and Management shall adjust the
- 7 institutional educator pay plan if necessary to ensure that salaries in the pay plan are
- 8 adequate to recruit and retain qualified institutional educators.
