## **Deer - Seasons and Bonus Stamps**

3 FOR the purpose of altering certain provisions relating to deer stamps; eliminating

- 4 certain provisions relating to deer hunting in Dorchester County; providing that
- 5 a bonus deer stamp purchased in one season may be used in a subsequent
- 6 season during the same hunting year; altering certain fees a certain fee;

4 [(g)] (F) Any person who, while operating a motor vehicle on any highway in 5 the State, accidentally strikes and kills a deer on the highway may have the deer if

6 the person produces visible evidence of collision with the deer to any Natural

7 Resources police officer, State law enforcement officer, or other designated

8 representative of the Secretary. The provisions of this subsection shall be applicable

9 to deer killed by collision with a motor vehicle at any time whether during the open

10 season for killing deer or during the legally closed season.

11 [(h)] (G) A person may not hunt a deer while the deer is taking refuge in or 12 swimming through the waters of the State.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectJuly 1, 1998.
