10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 24 - Political Subdivisions - Miscellaneous Provisions

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14 (a) Subject to the limitations in subsections (b) and (c) of this section, the hotel 15 rental tax rate is the rate that the authorized county sets by resolution.

- 16 (b) An authorized county may not set a hotel rental tax rate that exceeds:
- 17 (1) 3% in a code county;
- 18 (2) 5% in Calvert County;
- 19 (3) 3% in Cecil County;
- 20 (4) 5% in Charles County;
- 21 (5) 4% in Dorchester County;
- 22 (6) 5% in Garrett County;
- 23 (7) 3% in Harford County;

2		(9)	[3%] 5% in Somerset County;

6 (c) Notwithstanding subsection (b)(1) of this section, a code county may set a 7 hotel rental tax rate that is greater than 3%, but not exceeding 5%, with the 8 unanimous consent of the county commissioners for the county.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 July 1, 1998.

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
