17	(1)	for the	period of partial dependency; or	
18 19	PAID; AND	(I)	FOR A PARTLY DEPENDENT SPOUSE, UNTIL \$45,000 HAS BEEN	
20		(II)	FOR ANY OTHER INDIVIDUAL, until \$17,500 has been paid.	
23	(d) (1) Subject to paragraph (2) of this subsection, if a surviving spouse who is partly dependent remarries and does not have dependent children at the time of the remarriage, the employer or its insurer shall make payments to the surviving spouse for 2 years after the date of the remarriage.			

- 1 (2) The total of the payments made before the remarriage may not 2 exceed [\$17,500] \$45,000.
