- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 **Article - Natural Resources** 2 5-903.1. IN THIS SECTION. "FUND" MEANS THE PROGRAM OPEN SPACE 3 (A) 4 CONTINGENCY FUND. 5 (B) THERE IS A PROGRAM OPEN SPACE CONTINGENCY FUND. 6 THE FUND IS A CONTINUING, NONLAPSING, REVOLVING FUND NOT TO 7 EXCEED \$250,000 THAT CONSISTS OF THE AMOUNT OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR A **8 CAPITAL PROJECT:** (1) IN EXCESS OF THE AMOUNT NEEDED FOR THE CAPITAL PROJECT: 10 AND 11 (2) ALLOCATED TO THE FUND BY THE GOVERNOR. 12 (D) THE FUND MAY BE USED TO: SUPPLEMENT AN EXISTING APPROPRIATION FOR A CAPITAL 13 (1) 14 PROJECT: AND UNDERTAKE CRITICAL MAINTENANCE PROJECTS. 15 (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL EVALUATE EACH REQUEST FOR AN 16 (1) 17 EXPENDITURE FROM THE FUND. THE DEPARTMENT MAY REQUEST THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS TO 19 AUTHORIZE AN EXPENDITURE FROM THE FUND IF: 20 ALL REASONABLE ATTEMPTS TO REDUCE THE COST OF THE (I) 21 CAPITAL PROJECT HAVE BEEN MADE: NO PRACTICAL ALTERNATIVE EXISTS FOR SECURING FUNDING 23 TO COMPLETE THE CAPITAL OR CRITICAL MAINTENANCE PROJECT; AND THE REQUESTED FUNDING DOES NOT INCREASE THE SCOPE OF (III)25 THE CAPITAL PROJECT; AND PROJECT. (IV) 26 THE DEPARTMENT HAS PROVIDED WRITTEN NOTICE TO THE 27 SENATE BUDGET AND TAXATION COMMITTEE AND THE HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS 28 COMMITTEE ON THE REQUEST AND THE PLANNED USE OF THE FUNDS. 29 (3) PRIOR TO SEEKING APPROVAL FROM THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS, 30 THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET 31 AND MANAGEMENT SHALL:

(I) 33 THE PLANNED USE OF THE FUNDS; AND

PROVIDE WRITTEN NOTICE TO THE BUDGET COMMITTEES ON

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MONEY IN THE FUND SHALL BE DEPOSITED WITH THE STATE TREASURER.

- 1 (II)ALLOW 45 DAYS FOR REVIEW AND COMMENT BY THE BUDGET 2 COMMITTEES UNLESS THE ADDITIONAL FUNDS NECESSARY DO NOT EXCEED 20% OF 3 THE ORIGINAL APPROPRIATION FOR ANY PROJECT AND IN THE JUDGMENT OF THE 4 DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND 5 MANAGEMENT THAT THE ADDITIONAL FUNDS ARE NECESSARY TO PREVENT A WORK 6 STOPPAGE ON THE PROJECT. 7 (3) IF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AUTHORIZES AN <u>(4)</u> 8 EXPENDITURE FROM THE FUND, THE AMOUNT SPECIFIED BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC 9 WORKS MAY BE TRANSFERRED FROM THE FUND TO THE PROGRAM OPEN SPACE 10 ACCOUNT TO SUPPLEMENT THE SPECIFIED AUTHORIZATION. ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1 OF EACH YEAR, THE SECRETARY OF NATURAL 12 RESOURCES SHALL REPORT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, SUBJECT TO § 2-1246 OF 13 THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, ON THE MONEYS: 14 (1) DEPOSITED IN THE FUND; 15 AUTHORIZED FOR EXPENDITURE FROM THE FUND; AND (2) EXPENDED FROM THE FUND. 16 (3)
- 18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 19 July 1, 1998.
