BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article - State Government** 13 14 10-616. 15 This subsection applies only to public records that relate to: (h) (1) 16 police reports of traffic accidents; (i) 17 (ii) criminal charging documents prior to service on the defendant 18 named in the document; [and] 19 (iii) traffic citations filed in the Maryland Automated Traffic 20 System[.]; AND WARRANTS ISSUED FOR THE ARREST OF A DEFENDANT PRIOR 21 (IV) 22 TO THE ARREST OF THE DEFENDANT AND FILING OF THE RETURN OF SERVICE. 23 A custodian shall deny inspection of a record described in paragraph 24 (1) of this subsection to any of the following persons who request inspection of records 25 for the purpose of soliciting or marketing legal services:
