(a) 16 A University of Maryland police officer is and has all the powers of a (b) (1) peace and police officer in this State. 18 However, a University of Maryland police officer may exercise these 19 powers only on property that is owned, leased, operated by, or under the control of the 20 University of Maryland. The police officer may not exercise these powers on any other 21 property unless: 22 Engaged in fresh pursuit of a suspected offender; (i)

Requested or authorized to do so by the chief executive officer or

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- 1 (iii) Necessary in order to facilitate the orderly flow of traffic to and 2 from property owned, leased, operated by, or under the control of the University of 3 Maryland; or 4 (iv) Ordered to do so by the Governor. 5 In consultation with the Secretary of the State Police and the (1) 6 Maryland Police Training Commission, the Board of Regents shall adopt standards, 7 qualifications, and prerequisites of character, training, education, human and public 8 relations, and experience for University of Maryland police officers, including 9 standards for the performance of their duties. To the extent practicable, the Board shall adopt standards that are 10 (2) 11 similar to the standards adopted for the Department of State Police. Standards adopted on or after July 1, 1975, on minimum hiring 13 qualifications of University of Maryland police officers may not affect the status of 14 any individual who was a qualified University of Maryland police officer on that date. 15 The Board of Regents shall adopt rules and regulations governing the 16 operation and conduct of the University of Maryland Police Force and of University of 17 Maryland police officers.
- 18 [(e) The Board of Regents may authorize the presidents of the constituent 19 institutions to make use of a campus security force or building guards instead of a
