1 AN ACT concerning

2 Tree Experts - Definition

- 3 FOR the purpose of altering the definition of "tree expert" to require a person who
- 4 performs certain acts relating to trees to be licensed and subject to certain
- 5 regulations by the Department of Natural Resources; and generally relating to
- 6 tree experts.
- 7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 19 Article Natural Resources
- 20 5-415.
- 21 (a) In this part, the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 22 (b) "Licensed tree expert" means a person who has received from the
- 23 Department a license displaying his qualifications to practice as a tree expert.
- 24 (c) "Tree expert" means a person who [holds himself out as being]
- 25 REPRESENTS TO THE PUBLIC THAT THE PERSON IS skilled in the science of tree care
- 26 OR REMOVAL and who, whether in [his own] THE business OF THE PERSON or as the
- 27 employee of another person and whether under the title of arborist, tree specialist,

- 1 tree surgeon, tree expert, or otherwise, engages in the business or work of the
- 2 treatment, [and] care, [of] OR REMOVAL OF trees for compensation by:
- 3 (1) [making] MAKING diagnoses, prescribing, and supervising the
- 4 treatment for trees; OR
- 5 (2) TRIMMING, PRUNING, THINNING, CABLING, SHAPING, REMOVING, OR
- 6 REDUCING THE CROWN OF TREES.
- 7 5-416.
- 8 The Department may examine applicants for licensing as tree experts and pass
- 9 upon their competence.
- 10 5-417.
- A person may not engage in the work or business of a tree expert without a
- 12 license issued under the provisions of this part. An employee, under the supervision of
- 13 a licensed tree expert may not be required to have a license in [his own] THE name
- 14 OF THE EMPLOYEE.
- 15 5-418.
- 16 (a) The Department may examine an applicant for license as a tree expert and
- 17 pass upon [his] THE competence OF THE APPLICANT. It shall issue a "tree expert"
- 18 license to any applicant, who: (1) pays the fee provided in § 5-419; (2) has attained
- 19 [his eighteenth birthday] 18 YEARS OF AGE; (3) (i) has had 2 years of approved college
- 20 education in forestry, arboriculture, horticulture, applied agricultural sciences, or the
- 21 equivalent education and a minimum of 1 year of experience with a licensed tree
- 22 expert in Maryland or with an acceptable tree expert company in another state; or (ii)
- 23 for at least 5 years immediately preceding the date of [his] application has been
- 24 engaged continuously in practice as a tree expert with a licensed tree expert in
- 25 Maryland or with an acceptable tree expert company in another state; and (4) has
- 26 passed the examination given by the Department.
- 27 (b) Every licensee shall carry and show proof of liability and property damage
- 28 insurance, in the form and amount required by the Department at the time it issues
- 29 the license. The licensee shall maintain the insurance protection for the period the
- 30 license is in effect.
- 31 5-419.
- 32 (a) An applicant shall pay to the Department at the time of making [his]
- 33 application, a fee of \$30. An applicant who fails any examination, shall pay an
- 34 additional fee of \$20 for each subsequent examination [he] THE APPLICANT takes.
- 35 (b) A tree expert license shall be renewed annually. A person who holds a
- 36 license and wishes to renew it shall pay a \$10 annual renewal fee.

- 1 (c) Fees the Department receives shall be paid into the State treasury for the
- 2 Department's use. The Secretary shall prepare an annual report on the number of
- 3 licenses issued and the receipts and expenses under Part III of this subtitle during
- 4 each fiscal year.
- 5 5-420.
- 6 The Department shall prepare and conduct examinations as often as necessary,
- 7 but at least once a year if there are any applicants. A candidate who has passed the
- 8 examination in all but one of the subjects given may be reexamined in that subject
- 9 only at any subsequent examination held, and if [he] THE CANDIDATE passes that
- 10 subject [he] THE CANDIDATE is considered to have passed the examination. The
- 11 Department, however, may decide to reexamine an unsuccessful candidate in every
- 12 subject.
- 13 5-421.
- 14 (a) The Department may permanently revoke or temporarily suspend the
- 15 license of any licensed tree expert who is found guilty of any fraud or deceit in
- 16 obtaining the license, or guilty of negligence or wrongful conduct in the practice of
- 17 tree culture or care.
- 18 (b) The Department may promulgate rules of ethics and temporarily suspend
- 19 for a period not to exceed two years the license of any licensed tree expert who violates
- 20 the rules of ethics. This power of suspension is in addition to, and not in limitation of,
- 21 the power to revoke or suspend provided in subsection (a).
- 22 (c) A license issued under this subtitle may not be revoked or suspended until
- 23 after the licensee has a hearing before the Department. Notice of the cause for
- 24 suspension or revocation and the hearing date shall be sent to the licensee at [his]
- 25 THE last known address OF THE LICENSEE by registered or certified mail at least 20
- 26 days before the hearing. The nonappearance of the licensee after the required notice
- 27 has been given, does not prevent holding the hearing.
- 28 (d) The Department may reissue any tree expert's license previously revoked
- 29 under rules and regulations it prescribes.
- 30 5-422.
- 31 The Department may issue and grant a license to or otherwise authorize the
- 32 practice as a tree expert in Maryland by any person who is a lawful holder of a tree
- 33 expert license under the laws of another state which extends similar privileges to
- 34 licensed tree experts of this State. The requirements for the license in the state which
- 35 has granted it must be, in the opinion of the Department, at least equivalent to those
- 36 provided for in Maryland.
- 37 5-423.
- 38 (a) A person may not: (1) solicit, advertise, or represent [himself] THE
- 39 PERSON to the public as a tree expert, or assume to practice as a tree expert without

- 1 having received a license; or (2) after having received the license and subsequently
- 2 losing it by revocation or suspension continue to practice as a tree expert, or; (3) use
- 3 the title or abbreviation "L.T.E." or any other words, letters, or abbreviations tending
- 4 to indicate that [he] THE PERSON is a licensed tree expert or a tree expert without
- 5 having received a license, or when the license has been revoked or suspended.
- 6 (b) If the owner of a tree employs any person to [trim the tree, the owner is
- 7 not subject to this penalty.] ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF A "LICENSED TREE
- 8 EXPERT" AS PROVIDED IN § 5-415, THE OWNER IS NOT SUBJECT TO THIS PENALTY.

- 10 October 1, 1998.
