2 Financing for Elementary and Secondary Schools

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Maryland Health and Higher Educational
- 4 Facilities Authority to make its financing programs available to, and issue
- 5 bonds for, certain nonprofit elementary and secondary schools in the State; and
- 6 generally relating to the Maryland Health and Higher Educational Facilities
- 7 Authority.

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 43C - Maryland Health and Higher Educational Facilities Authority

- It is hereby declared that for the benefit of the people of the State of Maryland,
- 4 the increase of their commerce, welfare and prosperity and the improvement of their
- 5 health and living conditions, it is essential that this and future generations of youth
- 6 be given the fullest opportunity to learn and to develop their intellectual and mental
- 7 capacities; that it is essential that institutions for higher education AND
- 8 NONCOLLEGIATE EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS within the State be provided with
- 9 appropriate additional means to assist such youths in achieving the required levels of
- 10 learning and development of their intellectual and mental capacities; that it is
- 11 essential that hospitals within the State be provided with appropriate additional
- 12 means to expand, enlarge and establish hospitals and other related health care
- 13 facilities; that it is essential that institutions for higher education, NONCOLLEGIATE
- 14 EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS, and hospitals within the State be able to finance and
- 15 refinance projects at the least cost to the users thereof; that existing facilities for
- 16 [higher] education and health care and existing financing vehicles available to the
- 17 institutions concerned are insufficient to meet these needs and such institutions are
- 18 not able with present means to construct sufficient such facilities and adequately to
- 19 finance and refinance such facilities, in order to provide such facilities at the least
- 20 cost to the users thereof; and that it is the purpose of this article to provide a measure
- 21 of assistance and an additional method to enable institutions for higher education,
- 22 NONCOLLEGIATE EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS, and hospitals in the State to
- 23 provide, and to finance and refinance, at the least cost to the users thereof, the
- 24 facilities and structures which are needed to accomplish the purposes of this article,
- 25 all to the public benefit and good to the extent and in the manner provided herein.

- As used in this article, the following words and terms shall have the following meanings unless the context indicates another or different meaning or intent:
- 29 (a) "Authority" means the Maryland Health and Higher Educational Facilities
- 30 Authority created by § 4 of this article or any board, body, commission, department, or
- 31 officer succeeding to the principal functions thereof.
- 32 (b) "Project", in the case of a participating institution for higher education,
- 33 means a structure suitable for use as a dormitory or other housing facility, dining
- 34 hall, student union, administration building, academic building, library, laboratory,
- 35 research facility, classroom, athletic facility, health care facility, and maintenance,
- 36 storage, or utility facility and other structures or facilities related thereto or required
- 37 or useful for the instruction of students or the conducting of research or the operation
- 38 of an institution for higher education, including parking and other facilities or
- 39 structures essential or convenient for the orderly conduct of an institution for higher
- 40 education and shall also include equipment and machinery and other similar items
- 41 essential or convenient for the operation of an institution for higher education in the
- 42 manner for which its use is intended but shall not include such items as books, fuel,
- 43 supplies or other items which are customarily deemed to result in a current operating

- 1 charge; and "project", in the case of a participating hospital, means a structure
- 2 suitable for use as a hospital, clinic, or other health care facility, laboratory, training
- 3 facilities for nursing and other health programs, laundry, nurses' or interns'
- 4 residence, and such other structure or facilities necessary or useful for the effective
- 5 operation of a hospital, including parking and other facilities or structures essential
- 6 or convenient for the orderly operation of a hospital, and shall also include equipment
- 7 and machinery and other similar items essential or convenient for the operation of a
- 8 hospital in the manner for which its use is intended but shall not include such items
- $9\,$ as fuel, supplies or other items which are customarily deemed to result in a current
- 10 operating charge.
- 11 (f) (1) "Institution for higher education" shall mean an educational
- 12 institution situated within the State which by virtue of law or charter is a public or
- 13 other nonprofit educational institution empowered to provide a program of education
- 14 beyond the high school level and awards a bachelor's or advanced degree or provides
- $15\,$ a program of not less than two (2) years' duration which is accepted for full credit
- 16 toward a bachelor's degree, and which meets the standards, rules and regulations
- 17 prescribed by the Maryland Higher Education Commission and is thereby empowered
- 18 to issue a certificate, diploma or degree pursuant to Title 12 of the Education Article
- 19 of the Maryland Code. This term shall not mean any institution owned and operated
- 20 by the State.
- 21 (2) "INSTITUTION FOR HIGHER EDUCATION" INCLUDES A
- 22 NONCOLLEGIATE EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION AS DEFINED IN § 2-206 OF THE
- 23 EDUCATION ARTICLE THAT:
- 24 (I) HAS RECEIVED A CERTIFICATE OF APPROVAL FROM THE STATE
- 25 BOARD OF EDUCATION; OR
- 26 <u>(II) IS AN INSTITUTION OPERATED BY A BONA FIDE CHURCH</u>
- 27 ORGANIZATION.
- 28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 29 June 1, 1998.
