CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Community Services Trust Fund - Revisions**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the purpose of the Community Services Trust Fund such  
4 that certain proceeds to be received and held by the Trust Fund are not required  
5 to result from the closure of a Developmental Disabilities Administration facility  
6 or a Mental Hygiene Administration facility; specifying a certain exception for a  
7 certain period; providing that certain funds shall not revert to the General Fund  
8 and shall remain available for a certain purpose; repealing certain termination  
9 dates; and generally relating to the Community Services Trust Fund.

7 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
8 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

9 **Article 41 - Governor - Executive and Administrative Departments**

10 18-205.

11 (c) (1) The purpose of the Trust Fund is to receive and hold the proceeds  
12 from the sale or long-term lease of property and equipment [that results from the  
13 closure] of a Developmental Disabilities Administration facility or a Mental Hygiene  
14 Administration facility.

15 (2) For purposes of this section, proceeds are the gross proceeds minus  
16 the costs associated with the sale, lease, or disposition of property and equipment, as  
17 determined by the Department of General Services.

18 **Chapter 646 of the Acts of 1996**

19 SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take  
20 effect June 1, 1996. [Except for the provisions of Section 2 of this Act, this Act shall  
21 remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of May 31, 1999, with no  
22 further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no  
23 further force and effect.]

24 **Chapter 675 of the Acts of 1996**

25 SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take  
26 effect June 1, 1996. [Except for the provisions of Section 2 of this Act, this Act shall  
27 remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of May 31, 1999, with no  
28 further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no  
29 further force and effect.]

30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the provisions of this  
31 Act shall not apply to a Mental Hygiene Administration Facility located in Dorchester  
32 County.

33 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, notwithstanding any  
34 other provision of law, for fiscal year 1999, general funds appropriated in connection  
35 with the Waiting List Initiative within the Developmental Disability Administration of  
36 the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene that remain unexpended at the end of

1 the fiscal year shall not revert to the General Fund and shall remain available for  
2 expenditure on the Waiting List Initiative in the subsequent fiscal year.

3 SECTION ~~3~~ 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, at the end of June  
4 30, 2000, with no further action required by the General Assembly, Section 2 of this  
5 Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

6 SECTION ~~2~~ ~~4~~ 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take  
7 effect October 1, 1998.
