7 dates; and generally relating to the Community Services Trust Fund.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article 41 - Governor - Executive and Administrative Departments**

23 (c) (1) The purpose of the Trust Fund is to receive and hold the proceeds
24 from the sale or long-term lease of property and equipment [that results from the
25 closure] of a Developmental Disabilities Administration facility or a Mental Hygiene
26 Administration facility.

1 (2) For purposes of this section, proceeds are the gross proceeds minus
2 the costs associated with the sale, lease, or disposition of property and equipment, as
3 determined by the Department of General Services.

5 SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
6 effect June 1, 1996. [Except for the provisions of Section 2 of this Act, this Act shall

8 further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no
9 further force and effect.]

12 effect June 1, 1996. [Except for the provisions of Section 2 of this Act, this Act shall

14 further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no
15 further force and effect.]
