- 23 (c) (1) The purpose of the Trust Fund is to receive and hold the proceeds
- 24 from the sale or long-term lease of property and equipment [that results from the
- 25 closure] of a Developmental Disabilities Administration facility or a Mental Hygiene

1	(2) For purposes of this section, proceeds are the gross proceeds minus
2	the costs associated with the sale, lease, or disposition of property and equipment, as
3	determined by the Department of General Services.
