- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 Article Business Regulation
- 15 19-102.
- 16 (A) EACH COMMERCIAL BUSINESS WITH A PERMIT, ISSUED IN ACCORDANCE
- 17 WITH THE LOCAL ZONING LAWS OR ORDINANCES OF THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION IN
- 18 WHICH THE BUSINESS IS LOCATED, FOR AN ON PREMISE SIGN WITH LIGHTS THAT
- 19 ARE VISIBLE OUTSIDE THE BUSINESS SHALL REPLACE ANY BROKEN LIGHTS ON THE
- 20 SIGN WITHIN 2 WEEKS AFTER THE LIGHTS ARE BROKEN.
- 21 (B) A PERSON THAT FAILS TO COMPLY WITH SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS
- 22 SECTION WITHIN THE 2-WEEK PERIOD IS SUBJECT TO A PENALTY OF \$10 PER SIGN
- 23 FOR EACH DAY THAT THE LIGHTS ON THE SIGN REMAIN BROKEN.
- 24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 25 October 1, 1998.
