HOUSE BILL 568 (2) THERE SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE FUND ALL REVENUES 2 CONSISTING OF FUNDS RECEIVED BY THE STATE FROM ANY SOURCE AS A DIRECT OR 3 INDIRECT RESULT OF ANY JUDGMENT AGAINST OR SETTLEMENT WITH TOBACCO 4 PRODUCT MANUFACTURERS, TOBACCO RESEARCH ASSOCIATIONS, OR ANY OTHER 5 PERSON IN THE TOBACCO INDUSTRY RELATING TO LITIGATION, ADMINISTRATIVE 6 PROCEEDINGS, OR ANY OTHER CLAIMS MADE OR PROSECUTED BY THE STATE TO 7 RECOVER DAMAGES FOR VIOLATIONS OF STATE LAW.
