A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Agriculture - Aquaculture Advisory Committee**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the Aquaculture Advisory Committee;
4 giving certain members voting rights; and generally relating to the Aquaculture
5 Advisory Committee.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article - Agriculture**

19 10-1302.

20 (a) There is an Aquaculture Advisory Committee.

21 (b) The Advisory Committee shall consist of 21 members:

22 (1) 1 member of the Maryland Senate designated by the President of the
23 Senate;

24 (2) 1 member of the Maryland House of Delegates designated by the
25 Speaker of the House;

1 (3) 1 representative of the Department of Agriculture designated by the
2 Secretary of Agriculture;

3 (4) 1 representative of the Department of Natural Resources Police
4 designated by the Secretary of Natural Resources;

5 (5) 1 representative of the Department of Natural Resources, Tidewater
6 Administration, designated by the Secretary of Natural Resources;

7 (6) 1 representative of the College of Agriculture at the University of
8 Maryland designated by the President of the University of Maryland, College Park;

9 (7) 1 representative of the Department of Business and Economic
10 Development designated by the Secretary of Business and Economic Development[,
11 who shall be a nonvoting member];

12 (8) 1 representative of the Department of the Environment designated
13 by the Secretary of the Environment[, who shall be a nonvoting member];

14 (9) 1 representative of the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene
15 designated by the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene[, who shall be a nonvoting
16 member]; and

17 (10) 12 members appointed by the Governor:

18 (i) [4] 5 who shall represent the aquaculture OR AGRICULTURE
19 industry;

20 (ii) 1 who shall represent [seafood packers] THE AQUACULTURE
21 SUPPLIER INDUSTRY;

22 (iii) 1 who shall represent licensed Maryland seafood harvesters;

23 (iv) [1] 2 who shall represent the wholesale and retail seafood
24 industry;

25 (v) [1 who shall represent the agricultural industry;

26 (vi)] 1 who shall represent seafood consumers;

27 [(vii)] (VI) 1 who shall represent the scientific community; AND

28 [(viii) 1 member of the Tidal Fisheries Advisory Commission; and

29 (ix)] (VII) 1 member of the Boat Act Advisory Commission OR THE
30 TIDAL FISHERIES ADVISORY COMMISSION.

31 (c) The Advisory Committee shall formulate and make proposals for
32 advancing Maryland aquaculture, including recommendations for a fee structure on
33 aquaculture operations in order to reduce State expenditures on aquaculture
34 programs.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
2 effect October 1, 1998.
