2 State Personnel - Disaster Service Leave

- 3 FOR the purpose of altering the circumstances under which a State employee may be
- 4 entitled to disaster service leave with pay by repealing the requirement that the
- 5 disaster during which services are performed must occur in this State or a state
- 6 that is contiguous to this State; and generally relating to disaster service leave
- 7 for State employees.

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 Article - State Personnel and Pensions

16 9-1102.

- 17 (a) This section applies to all employees, including temporary employees, of all
- 18 units in the Executive, Judicial, and Legislative Branches of State government,
- 19 including any unit with an independent personnel system.
- 20 (b) On request, an employee subject to this section may be entitled to disaster
- 21 service leave with pay if:
- 22 (1) the employee is certified by the American Red Cross as a disaster
- 23 service volunteer; and
- 24 (2) the American Red Cross requests the services of the employee during
- 25 a disaster that[:
- 26 (i) occurs in the State or a state that is contiguous to the State; and

- 1 (ii)] is designated at Level II or above in the regulations and 2 procedures of the National Office of the American Red Cross.
- 3 (c) An employee may use up to 15 days of disaster service leave in any 4 12-month period only after obtaining approval from the employee's appointing 5 authority.
- 6 (d) For purposes of workers' compensation and the Maryland Tort Claims Act, 7 while an employee is using disaster service leave, the employee is deemed not to be a
- 8 State employee.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 October 1, 1998.
