21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
22 MARYLAND, That Section(s) 4-613 of Article 41 - Governor - Executive and  
23 Administrative Departments of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be  
24 Section(s) 4-614.

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland

3       (A)     (1)     THE DIVISION SHALL MAINTAIN A LIST OF ALL INDIVIDUALS  
4 CURRENTLY UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE DIVISION AND WHO ARE ON PAROLE,  
5 MANDATORY SUPERVISION, OR HOME DETENTION.

6               (2)     THE LIST SHALL BE UPDATED AT LEAST ONCE EVERY 3 MONTHS.

7               (3)     THE LIST SHALL CONTAIN AT LEAST THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION  
8 ON EACH INDIVIDUAL:

9                   (I)     THE INDIVIDUAL'S NAME, INCLUDING ANY ALIASES;

10                  (II)    THE INDIVIDUAL'S CURRENT ADDRESS; AND

11                  (III)   THE CRIME FOR WHICH THE INDIVIDUAL WAS CONVICTED.

12     (B)     (1)     AN INDIVIDUAL MAY REQUEST FROM THE DIVISION INFORMATION  
13 CONCERNING THE NAMES OF AND OTHER INFORMATION RELATING TO ALL  
14 INDIVIDUALS RESIDING IN A SPECIFIC ZIP CODE.

15               (2)     NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF STATE LAW, THE  
16 DIVISION SHALL RELEASE INFORMATION TO AN INDIVIDUAL REQUESTING  
17 INFORMATION UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

18     (C)     THE DIVISION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THE  
19 REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.

20     SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
21 October 1, 1998.
