2 Garrett County - County Administrator Position

- 3 FOR the purpose of providing that the County Commissioners of Garrett County shall
- 4 appoint a County Administrator; restricting the length of the County
- 5 Administrator's appointment; providing that the County Administrator serves
- as the County's chief administrative officer, responsible for certain functions;
- 7 requiring the County Commissioners to take certain actions pertaining to the
- 8 County Administrator's position; specifying that certain references to the Clerk
- 9 to the County Commissioners shall mean the County Administrator; repealing
- 10 certain provisions pertaining to the Clerk; and generally relating to the position
- 11 of Garrett County Administrator.

- 22 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 23 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 24 Article 12 Garrett County
- 25 [20-7.
- The County Commissioners shall employ a Clerk, who shall hold his office for
- 27 two (2) years from the date of his employment and until the qualification of his
- 28 successor. He shall be subject to removal from said office for inefficiency or for any

- 1 willful neglect of duty or misbehavior in office at any time by said County
- 2 Commissioners, who shall have power to employ some competent person for the
- 3 unexpired term of said Clerk so removed, and said County Commissioners shall be
- 4 the sole judge as to the inefficiency or willful neglect of duty or misbehavior of said
- 5 Clerk. The Clerk, before entering upon the duties of his office, shall give bond to the 6 State of Maryland in the penalty of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.), to be approved by
- 7 the County Commissioners, conditioned for the faithful performance of the duties of
- 8 his office, which bond shall be recorded in the office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court
- 9 for Garrett County, and shall take and subscribe before one (1) of the County
- 10 Commissioners an oath that he will honestly and faithfully, to the best of his skill and
- 11 judgment, execute the duties of said office. The Clerk shall be in charge of the office
- 12 of the County Commissioners, shall perform the duties pertaining to his office and
- 13 such other duties as may be prescribed by the County Commissioners or imposed by
- 14 law and shall have full power to administer an oath or affirmation to any and all
- 15 persons who are to be examined as witnesses in any matter before the County
- 16 Commissioners and touching or relating to any account, bill or other matter to be filed
- 17 in the office of said County Commissioners. The Clerk shall receive an annual salary
- 18 of not less than five thousand dollars (\$5,000.).]

- 21 COMMISSIONERS SHALL APPOINT A COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR ON THE TERMS AND
- 22 CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT AS THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND COUNTY
- 23 ADMINISTRATOR SHALL AGREE.
- 24 B. THE TERM OF APPOINTMENT OF THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR MAY NOT
- 25 EXCEED 4 YEARS OR EXTEND MORE THAN 6 MONTHS AFTER THE END OF THE
- 26 CURRENT TERM OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.
- 27 (1) THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR SHALL SERVE AS CHIEF
- 28 ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER OF THE COUNTY AND, TO THE EXTENT DELEGATED BY
- 29 THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, IS RESPONSIBLE FOR EXECUTIVE, ADMINISTRATIVE,
- 30 AND MANAGEMENT FUNCTIONS.
- 31 (2) THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SHALL ESTABLISH:
- A JOB DESCRIPTION AND JOB SUMMARY FOR THE POSITION OF 32 (I)
- 33 COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR; AND
- THE NECESSARY EXPERIENCE, QUALIFICATIONS, AND 34 (II)
- 35 TRAINING FOR ANY APPLICANT SEEKING THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR'S POSITION.

- IN GARRETT COUNTY, THE CLERK TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY (1)
- 39 COMMISSIONERS SHALL BE KNOWN AS THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR; AND

- 1 (2) ANY REFERENCE IN STATE OR LOCAL LAW TO THE CLERK TO THE 2 BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SHALL MEAN THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR.
- 3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
- 4 effect July 1, 1998.
