- 4 FOR the purpose of providing that, in Garrett County, the County tax collector is
- 5 required to advertise and sell real property located within a municipal
- 6 corporation in accordance with certain procedures when municipal property
- 7 taxes have not been paid; specifying the obligations of the municipal corporation

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 19 **Article Tax Property**
- 20 14-809.
- 21 (a) (1) When a property in a municipal corporation is delinquent in the
- 22 payment of municipal corporation taxes or charges levied against the property, the
- 23 appropriate municipal corporation official charged with the collection of taxes shall
- 24 notify the collector of the county of the unpaid taxes or charges on the property.
- 25 (2) If the procedures of this subtitle are not instituted by the county
- 26 collector on or before 30 days after receiving the notice from the municipal
- 27 corporation collector, the municipal corporation collector at any time after the 30-day
- 28 period expires may use the provisions and procedures of this subtitle to sell the

- 1 property for unpaid municipal corporation taxes or charges to the same extent that
- 2 these provisions and procedures are available to county collectors.
- 3 (b) (1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES IN CALVERT COUNTY AND GARRETT 4 COUNTY.
- 5 (2) [In Calvert County the] THE county collector shall use the provisions
- 6 and procedures of this subtitle on notification by the municipal corporation collector
- 7 of unpaid municipal corporation taxes and proceed to advertise and sell any real
- 8 property located in any municipal corporation in [Calvert County] THE COUNTY on
- 9 which municipal corporation taxes are delinquent.
- 10 (3) The municipal corporation, in which the property being sold is
- 11 located, shall buy in and hold, and pay the costs of the sale for any property offered for
- 12 sale for nonpayment of municipal corporation taxes only for which there is no other
- 13 purchaser.
- 14 (4) If the municipal corporation purchases the property at the tax sale,
- 15 the municipal corporation shall pay to [Calvert County] THE COUNTY any taxes owed
- 16 to the county and any costs incurred by the county in the sale of that property. If
- 17 [Calvert County] THE COUNTY purchases any property located in a municipal
- 18 corporation in that county that is being sold for delinquent taxes, the county shall pay
- 19 to the municipal corporation any taxes owed to the municipal corporation for that
- 20 property.
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 22 July 1, 1998 and shall be applicable to taxable years beginning after June 30, 1998.
