2 Sales and Use Tax - "Tax-Free" Week

- 3 FOR the purpose of designating a week in a certain calendar year to be a tax-free
- 4 week during which a certain sales and use tax exemption will apply; and
- 5 exempting from the sales and use tax a certain portion of the taxable price of
- 6 each item of tangible personal property sold during the tax-free week.

- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 Article Tax General
- 15 11-227.
- 16 (A) THE WEEK FROM SUNDAY THROUGH SATURDAY IN CALENDAR YEAR 2000
- 17 WHEN MARYLAND DAY OCCURS SHALL BE A TAX-FREE WEEK DURING WHICH THE
- 18 EXEMPTION UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL APPLY.
- 19 (B) THE SALES AND USE TAX DOES NOT APPLY TO THE FIRST \$100 OF THE
- 20 TAXABLE PRICE OF EACH ITEM OF TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY THAT IS SOLD
- 21 DURING THE TAX-FREE WEEK ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS
- 22 SECTION.
- 23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 24 October 1, 1998.
