(c) (1) In this subsection ["facsimile device"] "ELECTRONICALLY FILED 9 DOCUMENTS" INCLUDE [means]: (I) DOCUMENTS SUBMITTED FOR RECORD THROUGH a FACSIMILE 11 machine [that transmits, receives, and copies documents electronically or 12 telephonically over telecommunication lines]; AND 13 INFORMATION SUBMITTED FOR RECORD THROUGH (II)14 ELECTRONIC DATA INTERCHANGE. As provided in § 1-203.2 of this subtitle, the Department may accept 15 16 ELECTRONICALLY FILED documents [that are filed for record by means of a facsimile 17 devicel. 18 [Documents filed for record by means of a facsimile device] 19 ELECTRONICALLY FILED DOCUMENTS are subject to the regular filing fees and 20 expedited filing fees provided in § 1-203 of this subtitle. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE 21 22 ACCEPTANCE AND PROCESSING OF ELECTRONICALLY FILED DOCUMENTS. 23 REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE DEPARTMENT MAY PROHIBIT ELECTRONIC FILING 24 OF PARTICULAR FORMS OR TYPES OF DOCUMENTS. 25 1-206.
