

- 9 (1) One member in 1999;
- 10 (2) Two members in 2000;
- 11 (3) Two members in 2001;
- 12 (4) Two members in 2002; and
- 13 (5) Two members in 2003.
- SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 15 July 1, 1998.
