- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 Article Natural Resources
- 14 4-506.1.
- 15 (A) WHILE ON PRIVATE LAND, ON NONTIDAL OR TIDAL WATERS, OR IN AN
- 16 AREA ON LAND OR WATER MANAGED BY THE DEPARTMENT, A PERSON MAY NOT
- 17 WILLFULLY:
- 18 (1) INTERFERE WITH THE LAWFUL TAKING OF FISH OR OTHER MARINE
- 19 LIFE BY ANOTHER PERSON;
- 20 (2) HARASS, DRIVE, OR DISTURB ANY FISH FOR THE PURPOSE OF
- 21 DISRUPTING A LAWFUL FISHING ACTIVITY;
- 22 (3) BLOCK, IMPEDE, HARASS, OR DISTURB A PERSON ENGAGED IN A
- 23 LAWFUL FISHING ACTIVITY;
- 24 (4) DENY PASSAGE BY CREATING OR ERECTING BARRIERS TO AREAS
- 25 WHERE A LAWFUL FISHING ACTIVITY IS PERMITTED; OR

- 1 (5) HINDER A LAWFUL FISHING ACTIVITY BY PLACING OBSTACLES OR 2 OBJECTS IN WATERS OF THE STATE.
- 3 (B) A NATURAL RESOURCES POLICE OFFICER OR OTHER POLICE OFFICER OF 4 THE STATE WHO HAS PROBABLE CAUSE TO BELIEVE THAT A PERSON HAS VIOLATED
- 5 THIS SECTION MAY:
- 6 (1) ORDER THE PERSON TO DESIST OR TO LEAVE THE AREA; OR
- 7 (2) ARREST THE PERSON WHO REFUSES TO DESIST OR TO LEAVE THE 8 AREA.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 October 1, 1998.
