| 17 (A) WHILE ON PRIVATE LAND, ON NONTIDAL OR TIDAL WATERS, OR IN AN |
| 18 AREA ON LAND OR WATER MANAGED BY THE DEPARTMENT OR PUBLIC LAND, OR |
| 19 MARYLAND WATERS, A PERSON MAY NOT WILLFULLY FOR THE PURPOSE OF |
| 20 DISRUPTING A LAWFUL FISHING ACTIVITY: |
| 21 (1) INTERFERE <u>INTENTIONALLY</u> WITH THE LAWFUL TAKING OF FISH OF |

- 1 (2) <u>INTENTIONALLY</u> HARASS, DRIVE, OR DISTURB ANY FISH FOR THE 2 PURPOSE OF DISRUPTING A LAWFUL FISHING ACTIVITY:
- 3 (3) <u>INTENTIONALLY</u> BLOCK, IMPEDE, HARASS, OR DISTURB A PERSON 4 ENGAGED IN A LAWFUL FISHING ACTIVITY;
- 5 (4) INTENTIONALLY DENY PASSAGE BY CREATING OR ERECTING
- 6 BARRIERS ON PUBLIC PROPERTY OR ON PRIVATE PROPERTY WITHOUT THE

- 15 (B) (C) A NATURAL RESOURCES POLICE OFFICER OR OTHER POLICE
- 16 OFFICER OF THE STATE WHO HAS PROBABLE CAUSE TO BELIEVE THAT A PERSON
- 17 HAS VIOLATED THIS SECTION MAY:
- 18 (1) ORDER THE PERSON TO DESIST OR TO LEAVE THE AREA; OR
- 19 (2) ARREST THE PERSON WHO REFUSES TO DESIST OR TO LEAVE THE 20 AREA.
