1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Washington County - State's Attorney - Salary**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the State's Attorney for Washington County;

4 providing that this Act does not apply to the salary or compensation of the
5 incumbent State's Attorney for Washington County; and generally relating to
6 the salary of the State's Attorney for Washington County.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 10 - Legal Officials**

16 (v) In Washington County,

17 (1) The State's Attorney's salary shall be [80] 90 percent of the salary of
18 a judge of the District Court of Maryland.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III,
20 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or
21 apply to the salary or compensation of the State's Attorney for Washington County in
22 office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the
23 salary or compensation of the State's Attorney for Washington County shall take
24 effect at the beginning of the next following term of office.

25 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
26 October 1, 1998.
