In Washington County, EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN 5 (8)(I) 6 SUBPARAGRAPH (II) SUBPARAGRAPHS (II) AND (III) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, a Class A, 7 Class B, and Class C on-sale licensee may sell alcoholic beverages on Sunday from 12 8 noon to 12 midnight. THE CONSUMER PLACES AN ORDER FOR A MEAL 13 SIMULTANEOUSLY OR BEFORE PLACING AN ORDER FOR AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE; 14 OR 15 THE CONSUMER IS ENTITLED TO A MEAL ON THE 2. 16 LICENSED PREMISES AS PART OF A PREARRANGED EVENT. 17 WHEN A FEDERAL HOLIDAY FALLS ON A MONDAY, A CLASS A, (III)18 CLASS B, CLASS C, OR CLASS D ON-SALE LICENSEE MAY SELL ALCOHOLIC 19 BEVERAGES FROM 12 NOON ON THE IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING SUNDAY TO 2 A.M.
