A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Washington County - Board of Education - Terms of Members**

3 FOR the purpose of providing that at the general election in Washington County in
4 November, 1998, the three members of the Washington County Board of
5 Education who receive the highest number of votes shall serve a term of 4 years
6 and the two members who receive the next highest number of votes shall serve
7 a term of 2 years; and specifying that after the initial term each term shall be 4
8 years.

10 Chapter 531 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1997
11 Section 2

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Chapter 531 of the Acts of 1997**

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That [the]:

16 (1) THE new members of the Washington County Board of Education
17 provided for under this Act shall be elected at the general election to be held in
18 November 1998.

19 (2) NOTWITHSTANDING § 3-1301(C) OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE, THE
20 INITIAL TERMS OF MEMBERS OF THE WASHINGTON COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION
21 WHO ARE ELECTED IN NOVEMBER, 1998, SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS:

22 (I) 1. THE THREE MEMBERS WHO RECEIVE THE HIGHEST
23 NUMBER OF VOTES AMONG THE MEMBERS SHALL EACH SERVE A TERM OF 4 YEARS;
24 AND

25 2. THE TWO MEMBERS WHO RECEIVE THE NEXT HIGHEST
26 NUMBER OF VOTES AMONG THE MEMBERS SHALL EACH SERVE A TERM OF 2 YEARS;
27 AND

1 (II) AFTER THE INITIAL TERM, EACH TERM SHALL BE 4 YEARS.

2 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect

3 October 1, 1998.
