SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 3 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN WASHINGTON COUNTY.
- 4 (B) IN THIS SECTION, "BOARD" MEANS THE BOARD OF LICENSE
- 5 COMMISSIONERS.
- 6 (C) (1) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE A 6-DAY CLASS C (GOLF COURSE) BEER AND
- 7 WINE (ON-SALE) LICENSE AND A 6-DAY CLASS C (GOLF COURSE) BEER, WINE AND
- 8 LIQUOR (ON-SALE) LICENSE.
- 9 (2) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE A SUNDAY CLASS C (GOLF COURSE) BEER
- 10 AND WINE (ON-SALE) LICENSE AND A SUNDAY CLASS C (GOLF COURSE) BEER, WINE
- 11 AND LIQUOR (ON-SALE) LICENSE.
- 12 (D) A LICENSE MAY BE ISSUED TO A PUBLIC GOLF COURSE OR ORGANIZATION
- 13 THAT HAS A REGULAR OR CHAMPIONSHIP GOLF COURSE WITH A MINIMUM OF NINE
- 14 HOLES.
- 15 (E) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS:
- 16 (1) \$750 FOR A 6-DAY CLASS C (GOLF COURSE) BEER AND WINE
- 17 (ON-SALE) LICENSE;
- 18 (2) \$1,000 FOR A 6-DAY CLASS C (GOLF COURSE) BEER, WINE AND
- 19 LIQUOR (ON-SALE) LICENSE;
- 20 (3) \$250 FOR A SUNDAY CLASS C (GOLF COURSE) BEER AND WINE
- 21 (ON-SALE) LICENSE; AND
- 22 (4) \$250 FOR A SUNDAY CLASS C (GOLF COURSE) BEER, WINE AND
- 23 LIQUOR (ON-SALE) LICENSE.
- 24 (F) SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS.
- 25 A LICENSEE UNDER THIS SECTION MAY SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR
- 26 CONSUMPTION ONLY ON THE LAND AND IN THE BUILDINGS, INCLUDING THE
- 27 CLUBHOUSE, USED FOR GOLFING PURPOSES.
- 28 (G) A PATRON NEED NOT BE SEATED TO BE SERVED ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.
- 29 (H) (1) THE HOURS AND DAYS OF SALE ARE AS SPECIFIED IN § 11-522 OF
- 30 THIS ARTICLE.
- 31 (2) THE BOARD MAY REDUCE A LICENSEE'S HOURS OF SALE OF
- 32 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR ALL OR A PORTION OF THE LICENSED PREMISES.
- 33 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
