19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

HOUSE BILL 723

Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

3 (q) Correctional officers designated by the head administrative officer of a 4 county or municipal correctional facility under § 684B of this article have the same 5 powers of arrest for individuals on the property of the facility as are set forth in this 6 section for police officers.

7 684B.

8 (a) [Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, and subject] SUBJECT
9 to subsection (b) of this section, the head administrative officer of a county or

 $10\;$ municipal correctional facility may designate correctional officers employed by the

11 facility to have the power to make arrests as authorized by § 594B(q) of this article.

(b) Correctional officers empowered to make arrests under § 594B(q) of this
article shall meet the minimum qualifications, and satisfactorily complete the
training, required by the Maryland Police Training Commission.

15 [(c) Subsection (a) of this section does not apply to a sheriff who acts as a head 16 administrative officer of a county correctional facility.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectOctober 1, 1998.
