- 27 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages 2 10-103. 3 [(c) In St. Mary's County, in addition to the application and certificate (1) 4 requirements provided for under this section, each applicant for an alcoholic 5 beverages license shall be fingerprinted. THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO AN APPLICANT FOR 25 26 RENEWAL OF AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LICENSE. 27 THE BOARD MAY ESTABLISH A FEE TO COVER THE COST OF 28 OBTAINING: (I) THE APPLICANT'S FINGERPRINTS; AND 29 THE STATE AND FEDERAL CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS 30 (II)31 CHECK. 32 (6) THE BOARD SHALL: 33 (I) KEEP ALL CRIMINAL RECORDS CONFIDENTIAL; AND

- 2 ONLY TO BOARD MEMBERS, THE BOARD ADMINISTRATOR, THE BOARD'S ATTORNEY,

- 4 (7) A HEARING FOR AN APPLICANT FOR AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE
- 5 LICENSE AND THE ISSUANCE OF A LICENSE MAY NOT BE DELAYED DUE TO THE
- 6 FAILURE OF THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION TO PROVIDE THE
- 7 REQUESTED CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORDS CHECK BY THE DATE OF THE SCHEDULED
- 8 HEARING.
- 9 (8) THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THIS
- 10 SUBSECTION.
- 11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 12 October 1, 1998.
