- 3 FOR the purpose of altering the definition of "exterior surfaces" to include certain
- surfaces in certain areas of a multifamily rental dwelling; altering the definition 4
- 5 of "rental dwelling unit" to exclude certain common areas; and generally

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 14 **Article - Environment**
- 15 6-801.
- "Exterior surfaces" means: 16 (g)
- 17 (1) All fences and porches that are part of an affected property; [and]
- 18 All outside surfaces of an affected property that are accessible to a (2)
- 19 child and that:
- 20 Are attached to the outside of an affected property; or (i)
- Consist of other buildings that are part of the affected property; 21 (ii)
- 22 AND
- 23 ALL PAINTED SURFACES IN STAIRWAYS, HALLWAYS, ENTRANCE (3)
- 24 AREAS, RECREATION AREAS, LAUNDRY AREAS, AND GARAGES WITHIN A
- 25 MULTIFAMILY RENTAL DWELLING UNIT THAT ARE COMMON TO INDIVIDUAL
- 26 DWELLING UNITS AND ARE ACCESSIBLE TO A CHILD.
