## 2 State Buildings - Pictures and Web Sites - Missing Children and Elderly

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of General Services, the Department of
- 4 Transportation, and the University of Maryland System to reserve space in
- 5 State buildings under their control, subject to regulations adopted by the Board
- of Public Works, for the purpose of displaying pictures of certain missing elderly
- 7 individuals; establishing an Internet web site with information on missing
- 8 children and elderly individuals; and generally relating to pictures of elderly
- 9 individuals and State buildings.

## 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 17 Article - State Finance and Procurement

18 4-209.

- 19 (A) The Department of General Services, the Department of Transportation,
- 20 and the University System of Maryland shall reserve a reasonable amount of space in
- 21 State buildings under their control, subject to regulations adopted by the Board of
- 22 Public Works, so that:
- 23 (1) any law enforcement agency or State recognized nonprofit advocacy
- 24 group for abducted children can display the picture of a child abducted in a
- 25 noncustody-related abduction in the reserved space; OR
- 26 (2) ANY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY OR STATE RECOGNIZED
- 27 NONPROFIT ADVOCACY GROUP FOR THE ELDERLY CAN DISPLAY THE PICTURE OF A

- 1 MISSING ELDERLY ADULT WHO HAS A MENTAL DISABILITY, SUCH AS DEMENTIA OR
- 2 ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE, IN THE RESERVED SPACE.
- 3 (B) THE GENERAL SERVICES ADMINISTRATION AND THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 4 TRANSPORTATION SHALL JOINTLY ESTABLISH AN INTERNET WEB SITE THAT
- 5 CONTAINS PICTURES AND OTHER INFORMATION ON MISSING CHILDREN AND
- 6 MENTALLY DISABLED ADULTS.
- 7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 8 October 1, 1998.
