5 FOR the purpose of exempting ~~correctional officers of the Prince George's County~~
6 ~~Department of Corrections~~ and applicants for positions as correctional officers
7 in the Prince George's County Department of Corrections from the prohibition
8 against the use of a lie detector test as a condition of ~~employment~~, prospective
9 employment, ~~or continued employment~~; providing for the effective date of this
10 Act; and generally relating to the prohibition of the use of a lie detector test as a
11 condition of ~~employment~~, prospective employment, ~~or continued employment~~.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article - Labor and Employment**

20 3-702.

21 (a) In this section, "employer" means:

1 (1) a person engaged in a business, industry, profession, trade, or other
2 enterprise in the State;

3 (2) the State;

4 (3) a county; and

5 (4) a municipal corporation in the State.

6 (b) (1) This section does not apply to the federal government or any of its
7 units.

8 (2) This section does not apply to an individual who is an employee of the
9 Division of Correction and applies for assignment or is assigned to the special internal
10 investigative unit that the Commissioner of Correction expressly authorizes.

11 (3) This section does not apply to an individual who applies for
12 employment or is employed:

13 (i) as a law enforcement officer, as defined in Article 27, § 727 of
14 the Code;

15 (ii) as an employee of a law enforcement agency of the State, a
16 county, or a municipal corporation;

17 (iii) as a communications officer of the Calvert County Control
18 Center;

19 (iv) as a correctional officer of the Calvert County Detention Center
20 or in any other capacity that involves direct personal contact with an inmate in the
21 Detention Center;

22 (v) as a correctional officer of the Washington County Detention
23 Center or in any other capacity that involves direct personal contact with an inmate
24 in the Center; or

25 (vi) as a correctional officer of:

26 1. the Baltimore City Jail;

27 2. the Baltimore County Detention Center;

28 3. the Cecil County Detention Center;

29 4. the Charles County Detention Center;

30 5. the Frederick County Adult Detention Center;

31 6. the Harford County Detention Center; ~~for~~

32 7. the St. Mary's County Detention Center; ~~OR~~
