- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 17 Article 41 Governor Executive and Administrative Departments
- 18 18-316.
- 19 (A) THERE IS A COMMISSION TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF ESTABLISHING A
- 20 VOLUNTEER AUXILIARY POLICE FORCE IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY.
- 21 (B) THE COMMISSION CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS:
- 22 (1) THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY;
- 23 (2) ONE SENATOR WHO REPRESENTS PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY,
- 24 APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND;
- 25 ONE DELEGATE WHO REPRESENTS PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY,
- 26 APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES;

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- 1 (4) TWO MEMBERS OF THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY POLICE 2 DEPARTMENT, APPOINTED BY THE CHIEF OF POLICE OF THE PRINCE GEORGE'S
- 3 COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT; AND
- 4 (5) TWO RESIDENTS OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, APPOINTED BY THE 5 GOVERNOR.
- 6 (C) THE COMMISSION SHALL STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF ESTABLISHING A 7 VOLUNTEER AUXILIARY POLICE FORCE IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, USING THE
- 8 AUXILIARY POLICE FORCE IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY AS A MODEL.
- 9 (D) THE GOVERNOR SHALL:
- 10 (1) DESIGNATE THE CHAIRPERSON OF THE COMMISSION; AND
- 11 (2) ASSIGN PERSONNEL TO SERVE AS STAFF TO THE COMMISSION.
- 12 (E) THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION SHALL SERVE WITHOUT 13 COMPENSATION.
- 14 (F) THE COMMISSION SHALL REPORT ITS FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS
- 15 TO THE GOVERNOR AND, SUBJECT TO § 2-1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE,
- 16 TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY BY DECEMBER 31, 1998.
- 17 (G) THIS SECTION SHALL BE ABROGATED AND OF NO FURTHER FORCE AND 18 EFFECT AFTER DECEMBER 31, 1998.
- 19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 20 July 1, 1998.
