9 10	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 13	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:		
16 17	(1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Sojourner-Douglass College Loan of 1997 in a total principal amount of \$350,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general sobligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued,		

19 sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance

20 and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.

- 1 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as 2 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under 3 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 4 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer 5 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 6 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 7 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 8 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 9 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to Sojourner-Douglass College (referred to
- 10 hereafter in this Act as "the grantee") for the planning, design, repair, renovation,
- 11 rehabilitation, [and] reconstruction, AND EXPANSION of, and for the provision of
- 12 capital equipment for, [additions to] the Dunbar Annex of Sojourner-Douglass
- 13 College (Sojourner-Douglass College Administration Building).
- 14 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in
- 15 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and
- 16 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years
- 17 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 18 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 19 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a
- 20 matching fund of \$175,000. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided,
- 21 either directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or
- 22 unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of real property or in kind
- 23 contributions. The fund may consist of funds expended prior to the effective date of
- 24 this Act. In case of any dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money
- 25 or assets may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine
- 26 the matter and the Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1, 1999, to
- 27 present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will
- 28 be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact to
- 29 the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan shall be expended for the purposes
- 30 provided in this Act.
- 31 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 32 June 1, 1998.
